The Coral Reef HS Girls Soccer team had a breakout season in 2007 with a roster mostly filled with some very talented younger players. As we enter the 2008 season, we have every reason to truly anticipate even greater things at season's end with the return of those talented players from the 2007 season and the addition of some incoming freshman with great potential.

Since 2003, the Coral Reef Girls Soccer program has been headed by Coach George Maysonet. His teams have won 1 District championship, and have reached the Region finals in 2 of the 5 seasons with an all-time record of 79-32-9 .

Coach Maysonet's leadership has been instrumental in



helping prepare several of his players for soccer at the collegiate level. 8 former players have extended their soccer careers into Division 1 and 2 colleges. During these past 2 years 3 of 4 players earned starting positions their freshman year with all 4 making major contributions for their programs.
